

Attention all visitors

You are asked to answer screening questions, including current temperature.

Governor's mandate effective January 21, 2022: While a facility is in a local jurisdiction where the COVID-19 **level of community transmission** (CDC COVID-19 Integrated County View Site) is **HIGH (red)**, all visitors, regardless of vaccination status, shall be asked to provide proof of a negative test obtained within 72 hours of entry into the facility or to agree to be tested on-site using a point of care/rapid test. If a visitor refuses the request to provide proof of a negative test or to take a test, the visitor shall wear a face covering and physically distance in accordance with CMS and CDC guidance.

Please note: Visitors who exhibit symptoms or test positive may not visit.

If we are experiencing an outbreak (defined as one case or more), a sign will be posted on the front door. During an outbreak, after answering screening questions, please go directly to the room of the resident you are visiting and remain there until exiting the building.

Of interest: There are two different metrics for COVID-19. They are "Community transmission level" and "Community level". The metric that Nursing Homes use is "*Community transmission level*".
