Dear Residents & Family Members,

As you know, we are committed to keeping you well-informed of updates and changes with the impact of COVID-19 on our Friends House community.

With this letter, we are updating the statistics to match the "current" outbreak that began on December 21, 2021. See page two. This update corresponds to the report we submit to the State. The current guidelines mean that we test weekly and will update this letter weekly when there are changes in the information.

## **Visiting update:**

We continue to be in "outbreak" status. Still, the State of Maryland allows visitors under the following conditions. This means that "visitation is now permitted at any time for all residents, regardless of vaccination status, nursing home outbreak status, assisted living outbreak status, or implementation of transmission-based precautions."

Visitors must be screened at the front door of Stabler unit and proceed directly to the room of the resident they are visiting. The visitor is only to meet with the resident they are there to visit with. Do not mingle or speak with other residents and do not move to the hallways other than to enter and exit the building.

Visitors coming to Haviland will need to be screened at the double doors or the rear ambulance entrance (the door off the parking lot) and proceed directly to the room of the resident they are visiting. The visitor is only to meet with the resident they are there to visit with. Do not mingle with or talk with other residents.

Visitors must wear masks and maintain social distancing while in the hallways.

Thank you all for your patience as we answer the doors when the front desk is not staffed.

Please remember that the virus has not gone away, even after rounds of the vaccination have been administered, so it is still important to remain vigilant.

Please refrain from visiting if you are not feeling well, whether because of COVID symptoms or other symptoms.
