Dear Residents & Family Members,

We are committed to keeping you well informed of updates and changes with the impact of COVID-19 on our Friends House community. Please see the chart below for our current numbers related to positive COVID-19 cases for both residents and staff. These numbers are reflective from the very start of the pandemic. Since the last update, we had one staff member test positive for COVID-19.

Vaccine update:

We completed our first vaccination clinic on January 18, 2021. When the day was over, 45 staff members who work on the health care units were vaccinated with the first dose of the Pfizer vaccine. We also vaccinated 42 of the residents who reside in the health care units with the first dose of the Pfizer Vaccine. These residents and staff members will receive their second dose of the vaccine on February 8, 2021.

On the February 8, 2021 clinic we will have 32 more employees receiving their first dose of vaccination and 13 additional residents registered to receive their first vaccination.

The vaccination is available at no cost to residents and staff. CVS will charge each individual's insurance plan for any clinic or vaccination administrative cost. These vaccinations are for residents who reside in the Health Care buildings and members of the Friends House staff.

More information about the vaccination will follow as we receive it. Please check the Friends House website often for updates.
