Dear Residents & Family Members,

We are committed to keeping you well-informed of updates and changes with the impact of COVID-19 on our Friends House community. Please see the chart below for our current numbers related to positive COVID-19 cases for both residents and staff. These numbers are reflective from the very start of the pandemic.

Visiting update:

Please read below the process about visits there seems to be confusing information in the media and community about visiting health care facilities. We are <u>not</u> open for visitation as it was prior to the pandemic

All visits must be scheduled ahead of time. Scheduling will occur by calling the front desk at Stabler Hall, 301-924-7531 if your loved one lives on Thomas Hall or Stabler Hall or by calling the nurse station on Haviland Hall, 301-924-7518 if your loved one lives on Haviland Hall.

Reminder: We still have 30-minute indoor visits Monday through Friday from 1:00 pm to 5:00 pm.

IF TWO VISITORS. If there is one or two visitors for a resident and the resident resides in a private room, then the visitor(s) may visit in that resident's room. If the resident does not reside in a private room, then the visit will occur in a designated visitor location. If the visitor(s) and the resident are fully-vaccinated, then both the visitor(s) and resident can remove their masks during the visit.

IF MORE THAN TWO VISITORS. If more than two visitors come to visit a resident, the visit will occur in a designated visitor location, regardless if the resident resides in a private room or not. If all visitors and the resident are fully-vaccinated, then both the visitors and resident can remove their masks during the visit.

It is highly recommended that children under the age of 2 not come to visit. They are unable to wear a mask and more than likely have not been vaccinated. Additionally, children 16 years and under are not to be left unattended.

<u>Indoor visitation is subject to change at a moment's notice based on an outbreak in the facility or an increase of COVID cases in our local jurisdiction.</u>

Please note that only one visitation is allowed in the building at a time. For this reason, we strongly recommend that you schedule your visits by calling the phone number listed above to ensure you may have a time to visit your loved one.

Window and Skype visits are always available. If you would like to schedule a window visit, please call the front desk of Stabler Hall during regular business hours to schedule a time, or feel free to request a Skype or FaceTime call. The number is 301-924-7531. If you would like to schedule a window visit or FaceTime call for a resident who lives in Haviland Hall (Assisted Living), please call 301-924-7518.
