We have a report of a positive employee case. This staff member is fully vaccinated and also received the booster vaccine.

Visiting update:

As a result of these positive tests, we must stop all indoor visits effective immediately until further notice. We will notify residents and families when we will be open again for indoor visits. Please check the website for updates.
